

NewsBug Download Instructions Internet Explorer & Firefox Browsers

Go to <http://www.newsbug.afsaf.org/> to register.



Click the box agreeing to the **Terms of Use and Privacy Policy**, and then click **Register**.


Step 2: Check e-mail and confirm registration

After you click **Register** in Step 1 above, the screen below will be displayed, acknowledging your registration and instructing you to check your e-mail for instructions on confirming your registration, and downloading the NewsBug installation files.



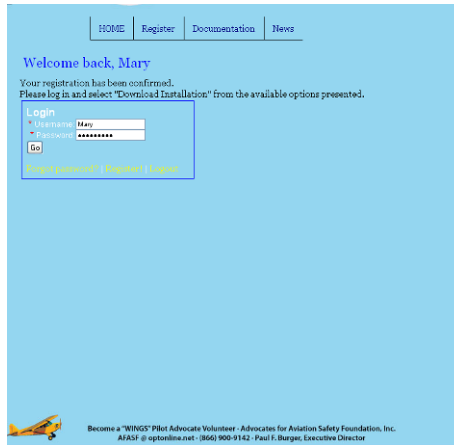

Step 3: Login to site



Enter your **Username** and **Password** in the fields provided, and click **Go**. The screen below will be displayed; click 'Click here to download the NewsBug installation file'.

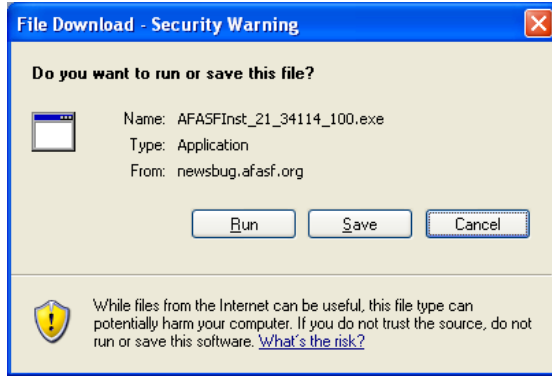


Step 4: Follow instructions to download

PLEASE NOTE: At this point in the download/installation process, the steps will vary slightly depending on whether you use Internet Explorer or Firefox as your web browser. If you use Internet Explorer, please follow the instructions below for **Internet Explorer**. If you use Firefox, please follow the instructions below for **Firefox**.

Internet Explorer

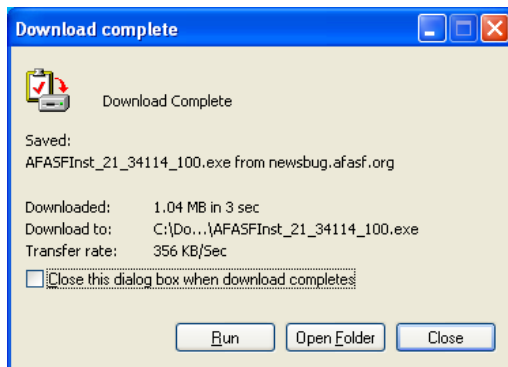
After clicking '**Click here to download the NewsBug installation file**', the window below will be displayed letting you know you are about to download NewsBug installation files. Click **Save**.



You will be able to select where on your computer you wish to save the file. You may [1] choose the folder in which to save the file, [2] accept the location displayed in the window or, [3] choose your computer's desktop by clicking "Desktop" on the left side of the window. Remember where the file is located and its name so you can find the program later, if needed.

Click **Save** to begin the download of NewsBug installation files to your computer.

When the download is complete, the window below will be displayed:



You may select 1 of 3 options in the window above to start installation of NewsBug. You can [1] click **Run** to start installation now, [2] click **Open Folder** to start installation from the location you saved the files, or [3] click **Close** this window and do nothing.

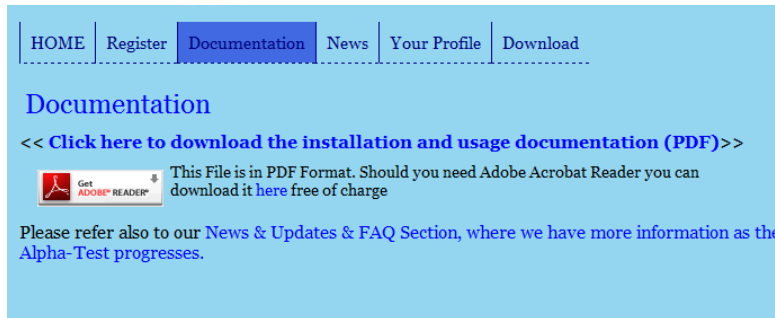
The window below may be displayed, asking if you are sure you want to run the software downloaded. Click **Run**, to start installation.

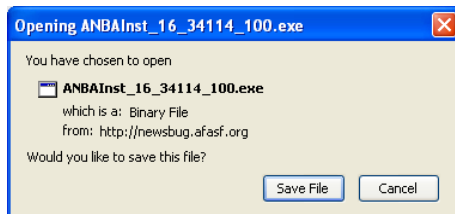


The screen below will be displayed; click 'Click here to download installation and usage documentation (PDF)'.

Firefox

After clicking '**Click here to download the NewsBug installation file**', the window below will be displayed, letting you know you are about to download NewsBug installation files. Click **Save File**.

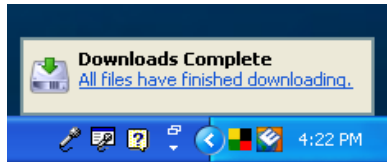


You will be able to select where on your computer you wish to save the file. You may [1] choose the folder in which to save the file, [2] accept the location displayed in the

Depending upon your browser version or browser settings, the window below may or may not be displayed in the lower right corner of your screen, when download is complete.



You can now go to where the newly downloaded NewsBug installation file is located on your computer, and double click on the file name, to start installation.
